



## The Six Conditions of Learning?

The Coalition for Community Schools has outlined **Six Conditions for Learning** which are recognized as a guide for the field.

<b>Condition #1</b>	Early childhood development programs are available to nurture growth and development.
<b>Condition #2</b>	The school has a core instructional program with qualified teachers, a challenging curriculum, and high standards and expectations for students.
<b>Condition #3</b>	Students are motivated and engaged in learning — both in school and in community settings, during and after school.
<b>Condition #4</b>	The basic physical, mental and emotional health needs of young people and their families are recognized and addressed.
<b>Condition #5</b>	There is mutual respect and effective collaboration among parents, families and school staff.
<b>Condition #6</b>	Community engagement, together with school efforts, promote a school climate that is safe, supportive and respectful and connects students to a broader learning community.
